## CHAPTER 50: GARBAGE

50.99 Penalty

### **§ 50.01 TRASH PLACEMENT FOR COLLECTION; STORAGE.**

(A) It shall be unlawful for any person to store or place trash or garbage for collection nearer to any street in the city than the front line of the residences facing said street, provided that should garbage be placed for collection on any vacant lot, it shall not be placed for collection nearer the front of said lot than the front line of the residence erected nearest said vacant lot.

(B) It shall be unlawful for any person to store or place trash or garbage for regular collection, at or near the front line of the residence facing the street, at any time earlier than 24 hours prior to the scheduled pickup; and it also shall be unlawful for any person to leave emptied garbage containers at or near the front line of the residence facing the street, at any time later than 24 hours after said pickup, weather permitting.

(C) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to collect for hire any trash or garbage stored or placed for collection in any place in violation of division (A) above.

### **§ 50.99 PENALTY.**

Any person violating any provision of § 50.01 shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction, be given a warning or punishment of a fine not less than \$10 nor more than \$100 for each offense and each day of such violation shall constitutes a separate offense.
