February 14, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the City of Norbourne Estates Board of Commissioners was held on February 14, 2012, at the St. Matthews Eline Library. Mayor Spanyer called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. The following City officials were in attendance: Mayor Spanyer, Commissioner Erny, Commissioner Frey and Clerk Brown. Commissioners Distler and Winkler and Treasurer Rose were absent. Two guests also attended. Attendance Record is on file.

Comm. Frey made a motion to approve and distribute the January 10, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes and a notice of safety reminders. Comm. Erny seconded; it passed unanimously.

Due to the Treasurer's absence, the Treasurer's Report for January 2012 was not presented.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Security & Finance

Security Officer Lt. Cabrera's reports were received. Clerk Brown read Lt. Cabrera's overview that no break-ins had been reported since changing patrol frequency and hours.

Clerk Brown reported that all current year property tax payments have been received. The only outstanding delinquency remaining is from the 2008 tax year and is in foreclosure status.

Comm. Frey reported on the progress in developing a website for the City of Norbourne Estates. He has received a proposal from Sumy Designs to develop the site similar to the City of Richlawn's. Mayor Spanyer made a motion to approve an amount not to exceed \$600.00 to develop the site. Comm. Erny seconded the motion; it passed unanimously.

Grounds & Sanitation

Mayor Spanyer reported on a complaint that sanitation/recycling trucks routinely come into the city before 6:00am and are extremely noisy. Waste Management has been contacted and agree to cease early morning collection activity until after 7:00am.

Comm. Erny reported receiving complaints and has observed animals (dogs and cats) being allowed to run loose and pet owners not collecting droppings. As provided by city and by Metro ordinances, dogs and cats may not run at large, and all droppings must be immediately picked up by the person responsible for the pet. (Reference Ordinance 15, Series 2003, Section 840)

Mayor Spanyer made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:40PM.
