

# CITY OF NORBOURNE ESTATES

## August 28, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the City of Norbourne Estates Board of Commissioners was held on August 28, 2012, at the St. Matthews Eline Library. Mayor pro tem Distler called the meeting to order at 7:00PM. The following City officials were in attendance: Commissioner Brooks, Commissioner Erny, Commissioner Frey and Clerk Brown. Mayor Spanyer was absent. Four guests also attended. Attendance Record is on file.

Comm. Erny made a motion to approve and distribute the July 17, 2012 Regular Meeting Minutes. Comm. Brooks seconded; it passed unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report for July 2012 will be presented at the September meeting.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS

### Security & Finance

Security Officer Lt. Cabrera's report was received. Lt. Cabrera reported no unusual activity for the month of July.

### Ordinances & Resolutions

Mayor Spanyer recognized Attorney Carrie Ritsert of Hodge, Singler & Ritsert, Attorneys who reaffirmed approval of the grant application for funds to develop new codes and ordinances for the city. The funds for our grant will be available near the end of 2012 or in January 2013, at which time American Legal Publishing will begin revision the City Code of Ordinances.

Clerk Brown reported that no candidates had filed for the four Commissioner positions in the City of Norbourne Estates in the next general election, November 6, 2012. Candidate filing deadline was August 14, 2012. In discussion, notice was made that a potential slate of candidates can be offered by filing as write-in candidates. The deadline for filing as a write-in candidate is October 26, 2012. No write-in votes will be tabulated unless the candidate is registered.

## **Grounds & Sanitation**

Clerk Brown reported receiving and circulating an email from Jeff T. Noble, legislative aide to Councilman Brent Ackerson, a resident of our city. Councilman Ackerson read in the city minutes an item concerning the tree at 418 Browns Lane, in the public right-of-way of Louisville-Jefferson County Metro. His office is working with Metro officials to have the tree removed and replaced.

Comm. Erny made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:45PM. Comm. Brooks seconded the motion.
